Every answer carries the reason behind it. Read the reason for the questions you got right as well — that is where you find out whether you were right for the right reason.

A. Multiple choice

1. **C) watched** — A regular verb adds -ed in the past simple, and last night is a finished time.
2. **C) moved** — Move adds -d because it already ends in -e.
3. **A) went** — Go is irregular and its past simple is went.
4. **C) Did** — Did carries the past tense in a question, and enjoy stays in its base form.
5. **C) Did you go to the party?** — Did already marks the past, so the main verb reverts to its base form.
6. **D) left** — Leave is irregular and becomes left in the past simple.
7. **B) didn't** — Didn't carries the past tense, so see stays in its base form.
8. **C) lived** — A verb ending in -e simply adds -d.
9. **A) studied** — A consonant plus -y becomes -ied: study, studied.
10. **D) stopped** — A final consonant after a single stressed vowel doubles before -ed.

2. **flew** — Fly is irregular and its past simple is flew.
3. **finished** — A regular verb adds -ed in the past simple.
