Every answer carries the reason behind it. Read the reason for the questions you got right as well — that is where you find out whether you were right for the right reason.

A. Multiple choice

1. **D) am reading** — The present continuous needs both be and the -ing form: am reading.
2. **C) is working** — Is plus working — the two halves of the tense must both be present.
3. **C) are cooking** — They is plural, so the auxiliary is are.
4. **A) Are** — The question is made by moving be in front of the subject; no do is used.
5. **D) I am taking a break.** — A silent final -e is dropped before -ing: take becomes taking.
6. **A) They are running late.** — A final consonant after a single stressed vowel doubles before -ing: run becomes running.
7. **C) isn't** — The negative puts not after be: he isn't working.
8. **A) She is working in the garden.** — Both halves are needed: the correct form of be and the -ing form of the verb.
9. **B) are waiting** — We is plural, so the auxiliary is are, and the main verb takes -ing.
10. **B) Is** — It is singular, so the question begins with is.
